Born in Milan January 19, 1972, he graduates with a degree in Political Science from the University of Milan in 1995.

His diplomatic career on begins on December 29, 1997, serving with the General Direction of Personnel while attending the professional training course at the Diplomatic Institute of the Ministry of External Affairs, Farnesina.

In September 2000, he is assigned to the Italian Embassy in Cairo where he deals with internal and international files and the news media.

On September 1st 2004 he is appointed Consul General in Liège, Belgium.

In June 2008 he returns to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation working at the Directorate General for European Integration where he handles community issues, and in particular, manages European financial instruments and cooperation programs for adhering and neighboring countries.

From December 2008 to June 2009, he attends the professional training course for Counselor of Legation at the Diplomatic Institute.

In December 2010 he is called to collaborate in the newly established Directorate General for the "Sistema Paese (Country System).

In February 2012 he is appointed Commercial Counselor to the Embassy of Italy in Madrid, and then promoted to Embassy Counselor in July of the same year.

On August 1st 2016 he arrives in Montreal and serves as Consul General and Permanent Representative at the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

From January 8th 2019 he is Diplomatic Advisor to the Minister for Environment, Land and Sea Protection, Sergio Costa.
