Nyctalus leisleri (Kuhl, 1817) Leisler's bat

<u>Measurements</u> – Head-body length 48-75 mm; Tail length 35-48 mm; Forearm length (37) 40-47 mm; Wingspan 260-320 mm; Weight 11-20 g.

 $\underline{\text{Ecology}}$ – A forest bat, found in woodland and typically roosting in tree holes. May also use bat boxes and buildings . Migrant, the longest known move is 1,567 km. Feeds on small Diptera, Lepidoptera and Tricoptera. Females give birth to one or two young in June.

 \underline{Range} –Occurs throughout all Europe, until the 56° parallel north, in northern Africa and in south-western Asia (to north-western India).

It is distributed in northern and central Italy, in Campania and Sardinia.
