

Plecotus sardus Mucedda, Kiefer, Pidinchedda & Veith 2002 **Sardinian long-eared bat**

Measurements – Head-body length 45 mm; Tail length 51 mm; Forearm length 40,9-42,3 mm; Weight 6,5-9,5 g.

Ecology – The species is found in woodland at low and medium altitudes. Roosts in caves, mines and buildings. There are no data about migrations, diet, reproductive behaviour, but the latter is presumably similar to the that of common long-eared bats.

Range – Italian endemic species whose distribution is restricted to Sardinia.
