
Subject: approval of the 2017 contribution to the Climate and Clean Air Coalition 2020 Five-year Strategy

Dear Ms. Molina Valdes,

following your letter submitted on November 30, 2017 and our previous discussion at the High Level Assembly on November 14 in Bonn, I am pleased to inform you that the Italian Ministry for the Environment Land and Sea (IMELS) will further contribute to the Climate and Clean Air Coalition to Reduce Short-Lived climate Pollutants (CCAC) Trust Fund with an amount of 74.233 € to be used for the CCAC activities and the Secretariat in line with the CCAC 2020 Five-year Strategy including Programme Support Costs.

The contribution should be spent by 2022. The reporting requirements will be fulfilled through CCAC annual report on the trust fund.
